Form the Airport to the Atocha Rail Station

<u>By Train C1 or C10 lines</u> in the terminal T4 of the airport ("Cercanías"). The price of the ticket is 2,60€. This service is operative every 15-20 minutes from 6 am to 10.25 pm.

By bus line 203 <u>(Airport Express)</u> in the terminals 1 (30 min), 2 (35 min) or 4 (40 min). This service operats every 15 or 20 minuts fro 6 am to 11.30 pm. the price of the tiket is 5€. The name of the bus stop in which you should get off is **Estación de Atocha**.

Once you arrive to Atocha you can take the <u>AVE Train</u> directly to Córdoba it takes 2 hours to arrive. We recomend to buy the ticket in advance given that it will give you a code called "combinado cercanias" it will allow you to travel from the airport to Atocha by train for free.

Directly form the airport to Córdoba by Bus. You can travel directly to Córdoba by bus from the terminal 1 with the company <u>Socibus</u>. It takes about 5 hours.





From Malaga Airport

If you arrive to Malaga Airport the best option is to take a bus directly from the airport with the company **ALSA**. Another option is to arrive to the train station and take a train to Cordoba.

From Seville Airport

Take a special bus that stops at the airport, **line EA.** If you wish to take a **train** (40) min) you need to get off at the Santa Justa Station, if you prefer to take a bus with the company **ALSA** (2 hours) you should get off at the bus station near the **Plaza** de Armas


WHERE TO LIVE
