Universidad Loyola is part of the International Association of Jesuit Universities (IAJU), with more than 200 higher education institutions all over the world.

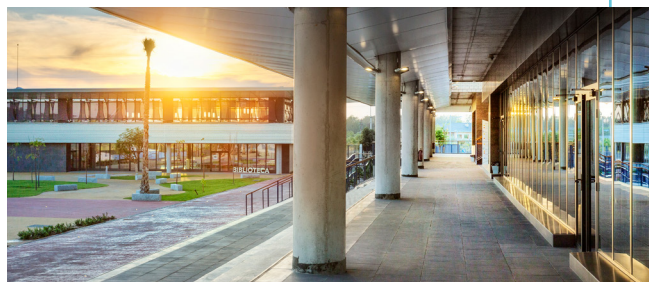


OUR CAMPUSES

HOW TO APPLY

UNDERGRADUATE

- 1 Admission process for Universidad Loyola: aptitude test and English/Spanish level test.
- 2 Homologation of the degree of pre-university studies at the Ministry of Education, Science and Sports.

POSTGRADUATE

- 1 To be in possession of a university degree that gives access to the Official Postgraduate Studies in Spain according to legislation.
- 2 Completion of the admission tests of Universidad Loyola: aptitude test, English test and interview with the graduate management.



TUITION AND SCHOLARSHIPS

The prices to study a university degree at Universidad Loyola range from 7.960€ to 14.980€ per year (to be paid in 10 monthly installments). The cost of university postgraduate studies varies depending on the field and duration. It ranges from 4.930€ to 29.285€ for double degrees.

Universidad Loyola has a wide range of scholarships and grants, which respond to academic and economic criteria. They are also compatible with any other public or private aid. Students from Jesuit Universities will receive a 10% discount.

DOCUMENTS TO STUDY IN SPAIN FOR NON-EUROPEAN CITIZENS

BEFORE **YOU TRAVEL**

- 1 Application for a student visa at the Spanish Consulate in your place of residence.
- 2 Admission letter from Universidad Loyola.
- 3 Valid passport or travel document.
- 4 Proof of financial means to cover the costs of the stay.
- 5 Medical insurance, public or private, authorized to operate in Spain.
- 6 If the course has a duration of more than 6 months:
 - Medical certificate
 - Certificate of criminal record.
- 7 Permanent connection with SEPIE and Study in Spain



AFTER **YOUR ARRIVAL**

If you will be studying in Spain for more than 6 months, within one month after your arrival you must apply for the Foreigner's Identity Card (TIE) at the Foreigner's Office or at a police station of the National Police.

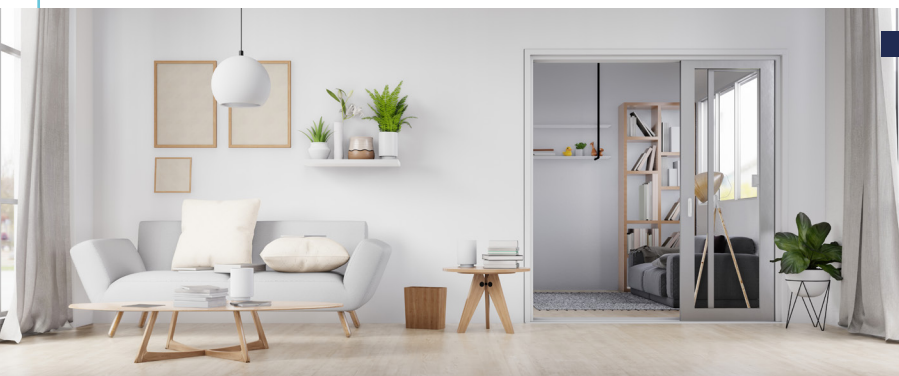
Andalucía, a melting pot of contrasts:

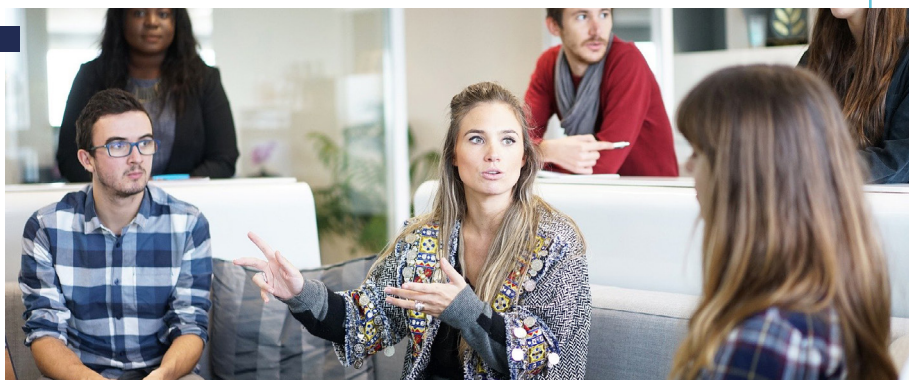


BUDDY PROGRAM
